QUERIES:- does JB b1811 really belong in this family ? If he does, then it wld be correct to presume that JB b 1798 died in infancy. Look for Essex burial 1798-1811 of JB ? The 1841 Census ref wld also make sense, and Auntie Di's story wld also be correct in part "master of a London Workhouse" - master - yes; London - no. If JB b1811 does not belong here, then I shld be looking for JB b1798. So - in 1841 he wld be 43 as against 30. Census records (see above) have not proved helpful.

Wait for the arrival of an 'age at death index' to search RGO indexes before 1866.

JSB: did he die (in office) in Huntingdon in 1845/6? If so, what became of Emaline and the children, John, Alice and Mary ?
