Note 7 From the Ilkeston Pioneer 10.01.1860 - On Sunday last, at Trowell Church, by the Rev. C. Hudson, Mr. Joseph Fletcher, lace manufacturer, Ilkeston, to Miss Sarah Hardstaff of Trowell. This puts the date at, Sunday January 6th - which is inconsistent with the marriage certificate.
