1886 - At school in London
1889 - Employed at Spottiswoode & Co. (Publishers)
1890 - Indentured 7 years as compositor
1891 Census: 0122.91.15 39 Tonbridge Street, St Pancras, London
1901 Census: 0142.18.28 129 King's Cross Road, London
1910 - Working as a reader at the Ballantyne Press - where he met Walter Harrap; (The Ballantyne Press was merged with Spottiswoode & Co. in 1916)
1911 Census: Wynstay, Golders Green Road, Golders Green, Middlesex
1912 - Joined Harrap's as head of the Editorial Department
C.C.W. retired from Harraps in 1940. He was proof-reader for Churchill's biography of Marlborough, for the Second World War and for the History of the English Speaking Peoples. At Chartwell (Churchill's country residence) the process of proof-reading was known as 'wooding'.

IMW says her mother lived for a while with an uncle & aunt, James & Catherine Henderson; she was engaged at 17, to be married in 1893; the fiance died before her 21st birthday; the uncle died March 1884 aged 40; the aunt died October 1910 aged 80. BWK came to London in 1897, to live & work as a teacher of dressmaking.
